Help us power life-changing operations

Imagine your local hospital having a power outage just before a loved one was about to have an important operation.

Now imagine that the hospital power cuts out for two hours a day, every single day.

It's unthinkable, isn't it?

Not for Kumi Hospital, five hours north-east of Uganda's capital city Kampala, where doctors and patients have had to get used to it.

Dr Nicholas Alinda, medical director at the 300-bed hospital, explains:

"On average we have about two hours per day of power blackouts on weekdays during the rainy season. This gets worse when it is stormy and power lines fall. This can lead to several days without power.

"Often when we are in the theatre, power can go off and we only see sunlight through the transparent roof sheets that are built over the operating beds. The power drills, suction machines, and fluoroscopy machines all stop.

"Also, the radiology department, laboratory, and accounts don't work whenever we have a blackout. This affects the outpatient department with patients being stuck in line. It is a huge challenge."

Dr Alinda, his staff and his patients are desperate for power and that's where we come in.

For this year's Summer Appeal we want to raise £16,000 to buy a new generator for Kumi Hospital.

The need is immediate, and the impact will be nothing short of lifesaving. Thank you for any support you can give.

Summer Appeal 2021: 75 new silos bought to help farmers in need

Thanks to everyone who supported our 2021 Summer Appeal. With your help we purchased 75 metal silos for around 50 small-scale Ugandan farmers to store food in their own homes. Without these effective air-tight silos, we expect at least one third of the farmers' harvest to rot or be eaten by pests before it gets to the people that need it.

Preventing these losses is therefore the difference between a family having enough to eat or going hungry, so thank you!
