Send a Silo to Save a Harvest

In rural Uganda it can be hard for smallholder farmers to grow a decent crop.

When the harvest does come, most farmers store it in traditional granary stores made with dried mud and grass.

Over time the food in these granaries rots, gets attacked by pests and develops dangerous toxins that make it inedible. Often entire stores of food are spoiled leaving families without food and income.

Our simple and effective solution is to Send a Silo to Save a Harvest.

Hermetically sealed metal silos reduce food losses to zero. This provides food security to vulnerable farming communities and a source of income to pay for essential needs such as healthcare and education.

We now have a queue of smallholder family farmers asking for a silo!

Since 2021 we have delivered 1,250 litre metal silos to 95 farmers in need, with a total storage capacity of more than 100 tons of grain!

This is also a social enterprise.

Our local NGO partner on the ground asks each farmer to contribute up to 40% of the silo cost to show their commitment to using it, and responsibility to look after it. This money is then re-invested back into the community to help more people in need.
